He Gives and Takes Away, Blessed Be The Name of the Lord

As many of you know, the Lord gave us a precious little one month old boy we named Aaron in April of 1985, while living in the Philippines. The Lord had spoken to Debbie and I that this child would be a sign to us of what He had called us to do in the Philippines. The Lord told us that as we looked at our malnourished Filipino son whom we would soon adopt, that he was weak and frail. "That is my church in the Philippines, it is weak and frail. As you take Aaron into your home and feed him and nourish him, he will grow and become strong. So will my church as it learns to feed upon my Word. That is why I brought you here to the Philippines, to teach my pastors how to study my Word."

Over the years we have watched the Lord bless the work of Intensive Care Ministries and the training of thousands of pastors and Christian workers all over the world. As Aaron grew over those early years we watched him become healthy and strong.



He often traveled with me to different countries and I always shared his story with the pastors. It became a beautiful picture of what God wants to do in the life of His church. We have seen many pastors and leaders take the training to heart and God has brought forth abundant fruit from their lives.

On March the 22nd, one day short of Aaron's twenty first birthday, the Lord called our boy home to be with Him. A motorcycle accident took his life. His memorial service brought glory to the Lord and many people accepted Christ and rededicated their lives. A week later at Aaron's former High School, a special all school assembly was held in memory of Aaron and many students gave their lives to Jesus.

Life goes on, but there has been left an awfully big hole in our hearts. We know that our Aaron will always be a sign to us of what God's Word will do in our lives if we obey it. We see today a tremendous undermining of His Word around the world. Many of our Christian young people are being deceived and many churches are diluting the truth leaving our young people ill equipped to face this world system with moral integrity. Instead of the church growing and becoming strong, many people are being pulled and swayed by pastor/teachers who tickle their ears. Unfortunately, many of our church goers leave the pews feeling good, but rarely challenged to make changes in their lives. This is an age where we need to be uncompromising faithful witnesses to the truths laid out so powerfully in His word.

When we told Aaron about it he decided that he was going to send his friend money each month out of his pay check to help him through college. We were so touched by what Aaron wanted to do, that we have decided to make sure his friend gets a college education. Aaron's memory will live on through others accomplishments.
